



#### **REGULATIONS GOVERNING SHRINE ELECTIONS**


From 2010 Imperial Bylaws (Iowa Corporation)

- 325.11 (a) **Electioneering.** The printing, publication, circulation or distribution of resolutions, letters, telegrams, tickets, e-mail or other devices by a Noble suggesting, recommending, opposing, or containing the names of proposed candidates for office in the temple is prohibited.
  - (b) Violation. For any violation of (a), the Imperial Potentate may suspend any offending Noble, and he may declare the election of the officers void and order a new election.
  - (c) Notice. At least one week prior to the annual meeting or any election, the temple Recorder shall mail to each member a notice thereof containing this section.




