





We start October 1st with a concealed handgun permit course. The instructors at Nebraska Shooters will again be leading the class with the assistance of the gun club's NRA-certified range safety officers.

The class meets all requirements to get your Nebraska concealed handgun permit from the state of Nebraska. Such permit is honored in 33 States. The class also includes a hot lunch. Each student will need a reliable handgun, holster and belt. You will also need 100 rounds of factory ammunition. The Sesostris members and their immediate family will enjoy a \$30 discount on this class.

The gun club will also offer a Halloween fun shoot October 29th. Let the gun club help guide you with a fun day of shooting safely with a little friendly competition. All firearms and ammunition provided for competition. \$30 covers the safety orientation and one entry to shoot all the stations and a meal. Additional tickets can be purchased for more ammunition. After the stations are complete a pumpkin carving challenge can be entered.

The gun club will assist you in carving a pumpkin, not with a knife but a pistol. \$10 covers the cost of your pumpkin and ammunition. We also will have several fully automatic Firearms available for those who want to feel some real freedom and cut some rounds loose at high speed. 
