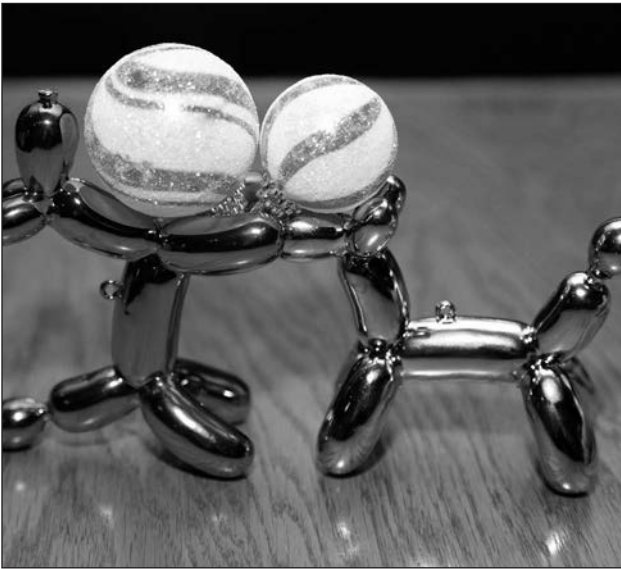
ABATE BIKE SHOW FEBRUARY 15-17, 2019

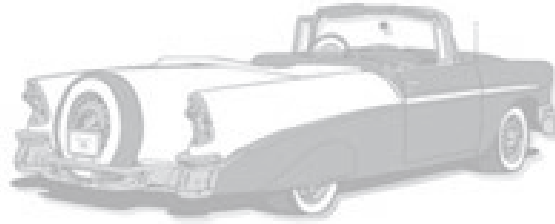


- SESOSTRIS CRUIS'N CLASSICS -

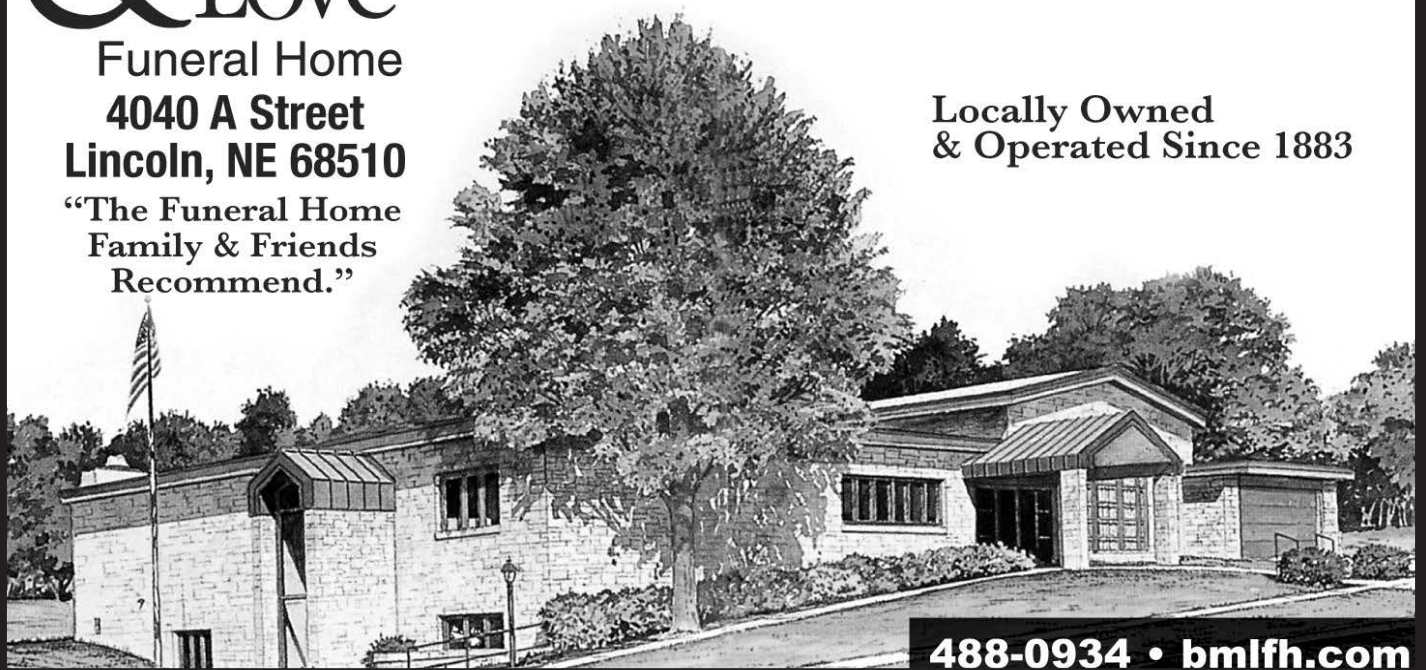

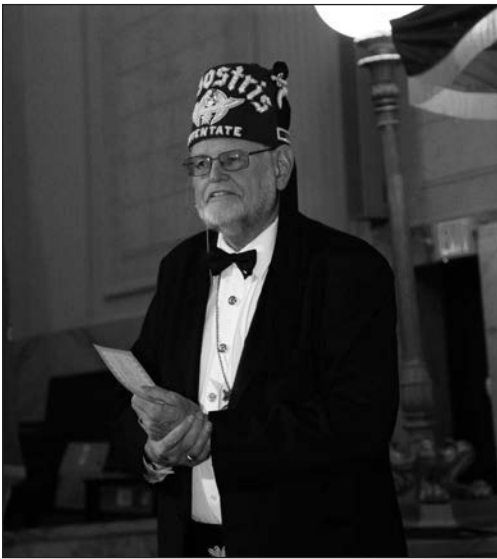

With Spring just around the corner, the Sesostris Gun Club is thinking outdoors and trigger time.

The Gun Club is again working with Nebraska Shooters to offer a Nebraska Concealed Handgun Permit class. This is the class required by the Nebraska State Patrol for application of your concealed carry permit.

The class will be April 20, 2019 starting at 8:00 a.m. and running to approximately 4:00 p.m. Nebraska Shooters range is located at 3200 Gage Road, west of Firth.

The class will cost \$138, but this year groups can earn discounts. If two people sign up together, they each receive a \$10 savings. If three people sign up together, each person saves \$15.

The Sesostris Gun Club will be on hand all day to assist the instructor as Range Safety officers and serving lunch during the break in class. Lunch is included with your registration.

You will come away from this class with a knowledge of ammunition and firearms. We will cover their operation and how to safely handle and store them.

A big part of the class is how to carry and the techniques for drawing and firing.

Once the class work is done, the class moves to the range. After running series of drills, each student will qualify with their firearm.

Don't delay and sign up with a friend or two for a fun day with the Gun club.

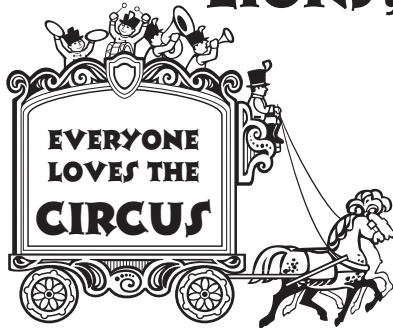

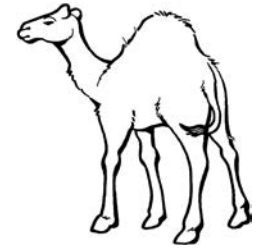
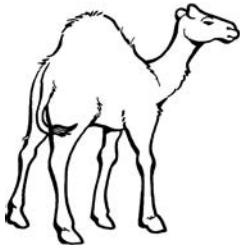

It's Vidalia Onion time again. I'm back for another year of onion sales. This year I am teaming up with the 2018 Shriner of the year, Noble Doug Krogman.

As I write this message, we just ended a winter day with a high of 8°F. I spoke with our onion grower today. It was in the 40's in Georgia and temperatures were forecast in the 70's. Our onions are in the ground and some rain and warm temperatures will really induce some growth.

This year the 10 pound bags of onions will sell for \$11. Sesostris has absorbed price increases from the grower as well as increases in transportation costs. We finally had to pass some of these costs on to the consumer.

It's time to start taking onion orders. Depending on mother nature, we expect our onions in mid to late May. This is a good time to remind our sellers that all our onions are to be presold. We also ask that the money for your onions be turned in with your order.

You earn \$2 a bag commission for orders turned in by March 15 and \$1 commission for orders turned in between March 15 and the 29th.

MEMBERSHIP INCENTIVES PROGRAM REVISED Effective January 1, 2019

1. Each line signer, in good standing, will receive one point for a new petition, a restoration or an affiliation.
2. After a Noble attains five points, he will receive a membership medallion with a red, green and yellow ribbon. For each succeeding five petitions, he will receive a diamond in his membership medallion for a maximum of five diamonds. Once he has been a line signer for 35 petitions, he will receive a gold ribbon to wear with his membership medallion.
3. Each TOP LINE SIGNER who is a line signer for TWO Nobles in any given calendar year will be eligible to receive a "membership achiever" polo shirt.
4. Each TOP LINE SIGNER who is a line signer for FIVE Nobles in any given calendar year will be eligible to have his Sesostris Shrine dues paid for the next calendar year.
5. Line signers, if they desire, may place the Fez on their new Noble during the fezzing ceremony.
