

Twin Cities Hospital Day Report

Dear Nobles and Ladies,

Although the weather was cold and dreary outside, it was warm and cheery inside the Shriners Hospitals for Children-Twin Cities during the annual Hospital Day. It was an honor for Laura and me to represent Sesostris on May 20. We were lucky enough to run into Noble Marshal Jairo Cabieles, his Lady Sarah and their daughter Cali, who had arranged their hospital visit to coincide with the weekend event. It was good to see some fellow Sesostris Shriners.

Over 500 guests came through the doors on Saturday to tour the hospital facilities and listen to presentations from the doctors, staff, and Rainbow of Hope award winners. Organizers also arranged for horseback rides, a trout fishing pond and a teddy bear patient booth.

Below are summaries on each of the Rainbow of Hope winners (they are pictured left to right):

Matthew Bores of Green Bay, Wisconsin was born with a condition of the hands and feet in which part or all of his fingers and toes are missing. At five-years-old he had bilateral amputation surgery and was fitted with prosthetic legs. Matthew started rehab in a wheelchair and then moved to a walker and that same summer was playing T-ball, surpassing all expectations.

In 2012, he set a goal to collect 100 handmade cards to deliver to children in the hospital. But with the help of Operation Write Home, he was able to deliver over 1,000 cards, donated from all over the country and as far as Australia. He also recently ran a pillow case drive, collecting almost 800 handmade pillowcases. His positive attitude and remarkable perseverance makes Matthew an outstanding role model to others. "I feel honored having won the award, because there are so many other kids that have done amazing things and it's humbling to be considered a part of that group," he said.

Cody Boyd, of Fargo, North Dakota started his journey at the Twin Cities hospital 19 years ago for treatment of a club foot. After four surgeries and countless adjustments, he graduated from the hospital last year. One of his favorite achievements is completing an 8K charity race in his hometown. "Without the surgeries that I had here at Shriners that would have not been a possibility," he said.

Cody has grown to become a leader in his community and an active volunteer at various charities. He loves volunteering because he says when he was younger he didn't have money to donate to organizations, so the next best thing was his time. Cody's now working toward his dream of becoming a mechanical engineer, studying at NDSU while working part-time.

Addie Hoheisel of Saint Cloud, Minnesota, had two surgeries at the Twin Cities Hospital for flat feet. This involved having her heels shifted, arches built with bone graphs, as well as her Achilles and calf muscles extended. She was in a cast or boot for almost two years. "Six years ago I could not walk the length of a football field without stopping and tears," she said. "After having both of my feet completely reconstructed by Dr. Noelle Larson, I was able to complete a children's triathlon."

Now 18-years old, Addie is passionate about being a role model for younger girls and giving back to the community. Over the past four years, she's organized a prom dress drive and collected over 300 dresses. The dresses are donated to the Shriners Hospital Prom, an event held annually for high school aged patients. Addie graduated from high school this year and is excited about what the future holds. She hopes to become a nurse at Shriners Hospitals for Children.
