

Football season in Nebraska is here, and it's a fantastic time of year! The Sesostris Shriners have a fall packed with fun activities and volunteer opportunities. The easiest way to pay your dues is through the link to our credit card payment processor, available on your WebFez profile page or your dashboard at www.shrinersinternational.org. Please ensure you are registered and have a login. If you need help registering and getting a login, the Shrine office can assist you. Please note that 2025 dues are due by December 31, 2024. Be sure that your lodge dues are current for 2024 as well. Remember, you must be current in your Masonic Lodge; if not, once we receive the suspension list from the Grand Lodge of Nebraska, we have no alternative but to suspend you from the Shrine. Remember the old saying: Every Shriner is a Mason, but not every Mason is a Shriner. Do you know a Mason who would make a good Shriner? Ask them to join Sesostris Shrine. I have petitions and information packets available in the Shrine Center office. You can also direct men to www. beashrinernow.com for information and an online Shrine petition.

We have Nobles who still need to pay their 2024 dues. If that is you, please plan to get your dues current or call the Shrine Center office and explain your situation. If you have a hardship, we can help.



#### SHRINERS INTERNATIONAL

A Fraternity Based on Fun and Philanthropy

Shriners International, a fraternity based on fun, fellowship and the Masonic principles of brotherly love, relief and truth, was founded in 1872.

The basic organizational units of the fraternity are chapters, dubbed "temples." Each temple is governed by an elected board known as the Divan; the presiding officer of the temple is the Potentate.

Within each temple, clubs and units unite members with shared interests and hobbies. From leadership development and public speaking to craft beer clubs, barbecue units and technology groups, there is something for everyone. The Shriners fraternity empowers members to be creative. While other organizations may offer a more prescribed slate of activities, Shriners are encouraged to create and build their own experience, forming new clubs and units around whatever their interests may be.

#### **IMPERIAL LEADERSHIP**

Together, all the temples support and govern Shriners International, which has headquarters in Tampa, Florida. The fraternity's governing board is the Imperial Divan, consisting of 12 elected officers and headed by the Imperial Potentate. Imperial Divan members typically are elected to move up one position each year, eventually becoming Imperial Potentate. However, in their specialized positions, the Imperial Treasurer and Imperial Recorder do not move up and may run for re-election to the same post.

#### A LITTLE HISTORY

In 1870, a group of Masons met regularly at a restaurant in New York City, the Knickerbocker Cottage. These good-natured and witty men often discussed their desire for a new fraternity, based on the fundamentals of Masonry but with more emphasis on fun and fellowship. Walter M. Fleming, M.D., and actor William J. "Billy" Florence began creating a new organization based on a Near-East theme that was popular at the time. The fraternity's official founding date is based on a meeting of Mecca Shriners in New York City in 1872.

#### **OUR PHILANTHROPY**

As membership in the fraternity grew, so did the call for establishing an official charity. The first Shriners Children's hospital, which opened in Shreveport, Louisiana in 1922, was dedicated to providing pediatric orthopedic care regardless of the families' ability to pay.

Today, Shriners Children's is a unique healthcare system that includes locations in the United States, Canada and Mexico, with outreach efforts extending care to children around the world. Shriners Children's offers high-quality pediatric specialty care in several areas, including orthopedics, burns, spinal cord injury rehabilitation and cleft lip and palate, regardless of the families' ability to pay or insurance status.

Shriners Children's relies on the generous donations of Shriners and the general public to continue its mission of improving the lives of children. Since 1922, Shriners Children's has brought hope and healing to more than 1.5 million children.
